

Rockbank station will be rebuilt as part of the Ballarat Line Upgrade to cater for the growing community.

YOUR FEEDBACK ON STATION PLANS

We asked local residents and passengers to have their say on our early plans to guide detailed planning and design work on the Rockbank station rebuild.

The feedback we received from the community is available online at regionalrailrevival.vic.gov.au.

The upgraded Rockbank station will have more than 350 car parks, better access for buses and pedestrians, improved security and lighting and landscaping.

Works will include:

- demolition of the existing station
- rebuilding two new platforms
- construction of an accessible pedestrian overpass linking the two platforms
- a new sealed carpark, bus and taxi bays, secure bike storage areas and drop-off zones
- setting aside areas for future station development.

Construction began in March and will be completed by the end of 2019.

WHAT IS THE BALLARAT LINE UPGRADE?

The Australian and Victorian governments are upgrading the Ballarat line to deliver more frequent and reliable services to Melbourne's outer western suburbs, Bacchus Marsh, Ballan and Ballarat.

The upgrade will enable much-needed extra services in the morning and afternoon peak, plus a train every 40 minutes off-peak for these growing communities.

Major construction began in late 2017 and will be complete by late 2019.
