BACCHUS MARSH STATION UPDATE

We're starting work in late June on rebuilding the northern car park at Bacchus Marsh Station. This will mean some major changes to car parking at the station over the next few months.

BALLARAT LINE CLOSURE

Coaches will replace trains on the Ballarat line from Monday 24 June until Sunday 7 July. Trains will resume from the first service on Monday 8 July 2019.

During this period, we'll be carrying out major works along the Ballarat line, including construction at Bacchus Marsh Station and building track between the station and new stabling at Maddingley.

NORTHERN CAR PARK CHANGES

From Monday 24 June, we'll need to close sections of the car park at Bacchus Marsh Station so we can start major construction on the station forecourt and rebuild the car park to include improved footpaths, bus bays, drop off zones and parking.

From this time until late 2019 we will:

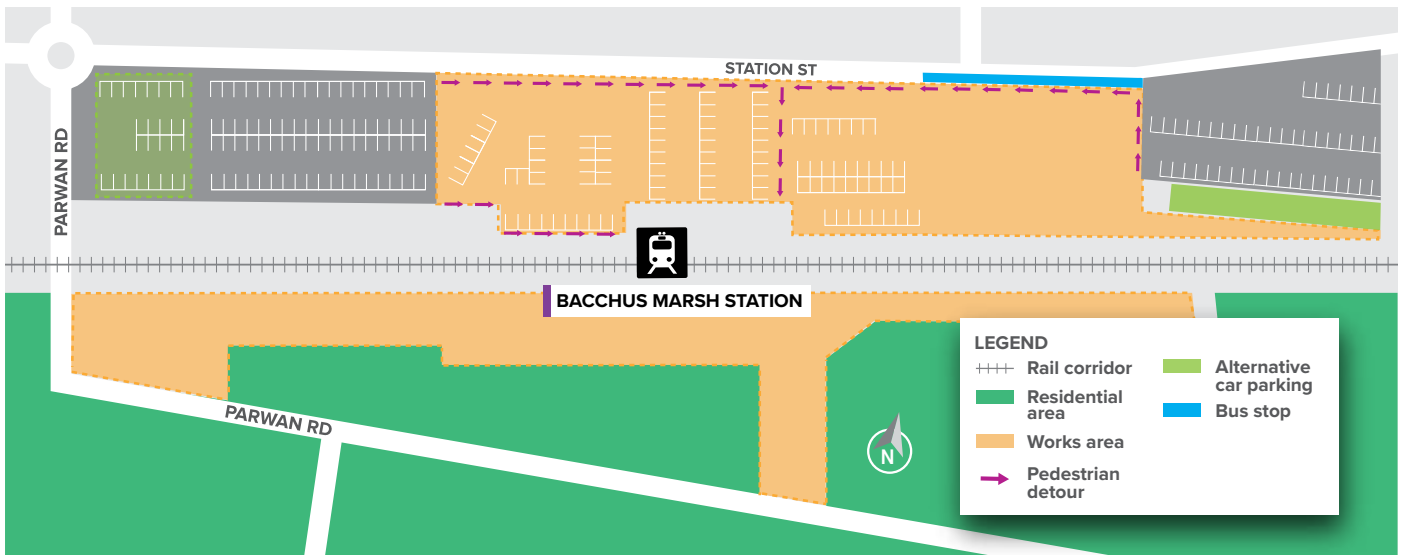
- Extend the construction zone in the northern car park
- Close some vehicle access points from Station Street into the car park
- Continue to provide accessible parking as close as possible to the station building
- Temporarily relocate bus bays to Station Street, near the historic turntable
- Put temporary pedestrian paths in place so passengers can safely access the station
- Create a temporary alternative car park between the existing eastern car park and the rail line
- Relocate the bike parkiteer, which will be closed temporarily for one week, please monitor on site signage.

We will program these works to minimise the impacts to car parks, pedestrians and cyclists.

We ask all station users to plan ahead and allow more time to locate a car park. We would also ask station users to walk or cycle to the station as alternative means.

Please be aware of changed traffic arrangements, which will be advised by signage, including electronic messaging, in the lead up to these changes commencing.

UPDATED DESIGN FOR NEW CAR PARK – SOUTH SIDE

The new car park on the southern side of the station is currently under construction, and when complete will increase car parking at the station by 100 spaces.

Following feedback by the community regarding road safety on Parwan Road, the car park will now have a single entry point and exit point adjacent to Mitchem Street, including turning lanes and pedestrian access from Parwan Road.

This means there will be less conflict between vehicles entering and exiting the station and those travelling on Parwan Road, or turning from East Maddingley Road and Love Close.

WORKS UPDATE

Ballarat line construction blitz

Continuous 24-hours works - 12.01am Monday 24 June – 11.59pm Sunday 7 July

For the safety of our workers and passengers, we will undertake the following work while trains are not running:

Bacchus Marsh Station

- **Crane lift** to install the new pedestrian overpass
- **Southern platform and car park** construction works, such as concrete pours and backfilling
- **Tree removal** from the north side car park and along the rail corridor
- **Service relocation and drainage works** in the north side car park
- **Temporary car park** establishment on the north side, near the turntable
- **Temporary bus bays** on Station Street, near the turntable

Between the station and Maddingley stabling

- **Kerrs Road level crossing** rail track installation
- **Construction works** associated with new rail track along the rail corridor
- **Heavy vehicle and machinery** movements

June - August 2019, 7am-6pm Monday to Saturday

We will continue work on the station upgrade and rail duplication, including:

- **Rebuilding** the northern carpark and bus bays near the station building
- **Overpass construction** works including building ramps, stairs and lifts
- **Installation of new station services** including lights, CCTV, and myki equipment
- **Paving** of the northern and southern forecourts and entrances
- **Station fit out** including cladding, landscaping, line marking of floor surfaces, bench seating, signage and handrails
- **Construction works** associated with new rail track along the rail corridor between the station and Maddingley stabling.

OUT-OF-HOURS WORKS AND DELIVERIES

During this period, some work activities and deliveries may be undertaken out of hours.

For disruptive works, directly impacted residents and businesses will be notified in advance.

WHAT TO BE AWARE OF

- Machinery and workers near level crossings, on local roads and within the rail corridor
- Reduced speed limits, signs and traffic management staff
- Dust generation. Where necessary, water carts will be used for dust suppression
- Vibration may be felt during car park construction works due to machinery
- Access to homes and businesses will be maintained at all times.

MINIMISING IMPACTS

Where possible, we will minimise disruption to residents in the following ways:

- Scheduling noisy works during normal working hours where possible
- Using broadband reversing alarms on mobile machinery that are quieter than reversing 'beepers'
- Using noise-reduced equipment
- Using machinery on lower vibration settings near residential property.

We will notify residents and businesses if there are any significant changes to the program.

All planned works are dependent on suitable weather and ground conditions.

DETOUR ROUTES AND TRAFFIC IMPACTS

From Friday 21 June, there will be changes to Kerrs Road in Maddingley, with traffic management in place:

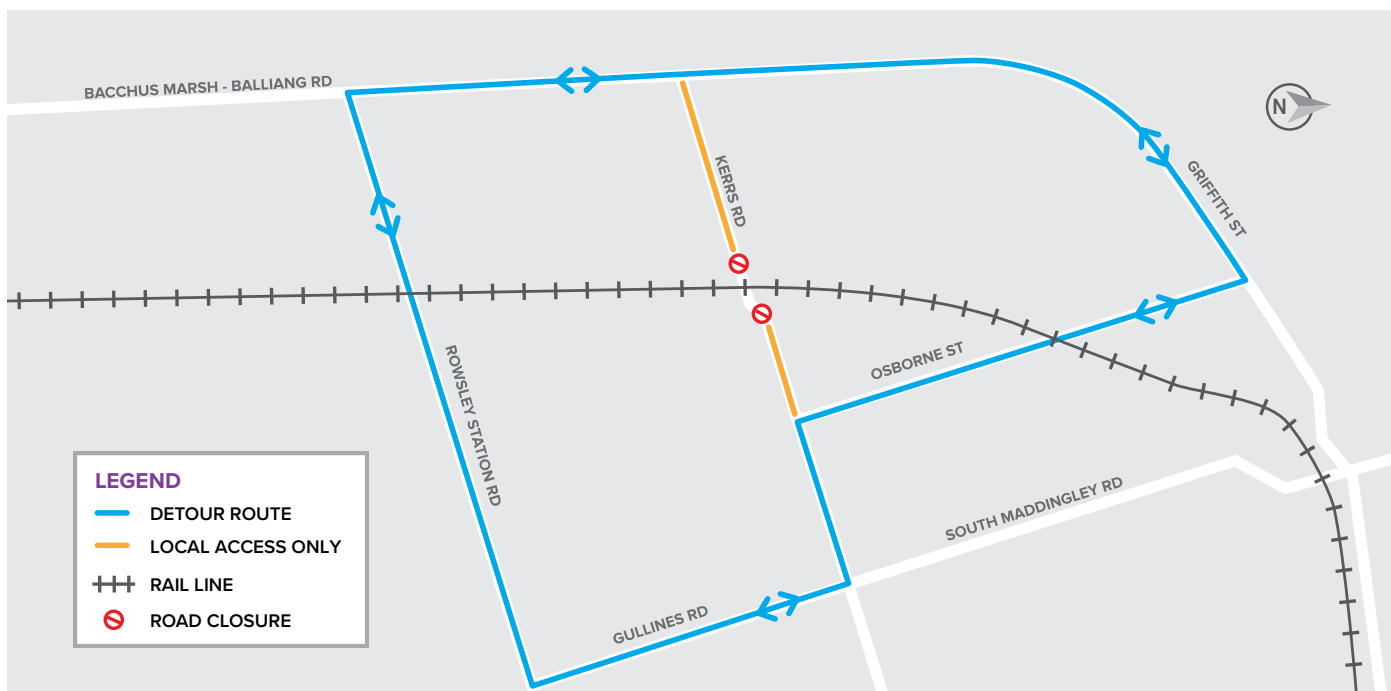
- South bound traffic from South or East Maddingley Road (along Kerrs Road) will be detoured at Osborne Street (north travel) and Gullines Road
- Traffic from Bacchus Marsh-Balliang Road will be detoured at Rowsley Station Road.

CHANGED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS AND REDUCED SPEED LIMITS

Traffic management will be in place for the safety of workers and the general public at the following locations:

- Fisken Street
- Parwan Road
- Station Street
- Grant Street
- Osborne Street
